Sandy Beach Shag Club's Sandkicker DJ Megafest. A little history of our event..

Our first Megafest was called the Sandkicker DJ Throwdown, held on September 4, 2011. Our party this year will mark the 6th anniversary of this party.

The name was changed as the DJ Throwdown held in North Myrtle Beach has a copyright on the name DJ Throwdown. Our first party had 10 DJs. It only cost \$15 to attend. That was a pretty amazing deal when you consider the meal alone cost about that much.

Brandi Dockery and Carlton Vinson were our guest instructors for the shag lesson that year. Our meal was hamburgers and hot dogs. We had snacks and a silent auction.

Our second party was called the Sandkicker DJ Megafest II. It initiated the current format of 12 DJs. We had begun our Associate Membership designation and charged \$20 to attend. The club went to a format of teaching a line dance lesson, and provided a catered meal. The party was held September 2, 2012. We called our DJs the "Dirty Dozen DJs" for the first time. This was the first time we conducted a Chinese and a silent auction. Door prizes were also a feature.

Our third party was called the Sandkicker DJ Megafest III and was held September 1, 2013. Our format stayed the same with the cost remaining \$20 to attend. This party sold out and was nominated for a Cammy Award for "Best Shag Club Event of the Year". This was our final year offering door prizes. We conducted a combination of Silent and Chinese auction.

Our fourth party was held August 31, 2014. The cost to attend this party was \$25 which is the current cost of the party. We introduced the Theme Baskets as part of our Chinese Auction and it was a big hit! We served a great catered meal and our format was similar, except the number of registrations and seats were

significantly reduced to make the party more comfortable and easier to get around.

This party sold out and Sandy Beach was again nominated for a Cammy Award for "Best Shag Club Event of the Year".

Our fifth party was held September 6th, 2015 and we limited the



number of seats once again. We introduced table hosts, which went very well. Our meal, which included barbeque, was prepared and served by our own shag club members. The cost of registration for our guests remained the same as in 2014. We once again were nominated for "Best Shag Club Event of the Year".

Our newest version will be our 6th edition of our Sandkicker DJ Megafest Party. The menu has not been decided at this writing, but we will again have our "Dirty Dozen" DJs, line dance lessons, shots and shooters, and great snacks and another fantastic Chinese auction.

In addition, we are introducing an all new concept called Shag Bingo! It is fun, keeps everyone dancing and gives everyone a chance to win a nice prize! AS in the past, we are holding true to our number of seats to keep the venue from being too crowded. We have had very favorable feedback the last two years about the flow of traffic and the seating arrangements.

Our team has worked very hard to bring our members and associate members a party that exemplifies what fun can be had at a oneday party.

All of this was to honor the old two day

Sandkicker party that was once proud to have some of shag's greatest dancers attend. I never had the privilege of attending one of these parties, but the first day was held at what is now Friday Friends, and the second day was held at the Elks Lodge. We hope that our Sandkicker DJ Megafest will also become a legendary party. Please invite all of your shag friends to join us. Just make sure you don't delay your chance to register!
