We finally received some mild weather at the right time for our Friday Friends Deck Party Sunday June 28th. Mac

Mast was our DJ. Attendance was very good and all had a good time dancing and spending time together. Our regular party for June was a success even though attendance was not as high as other months. This seems to be a normal thing for summer months due to travel and many other activities for folks to participate.

Fun Monday tickets are now on sale. James Bentley is heading up a big part of the sales as well as Ron Spencer and Les Harbinson in addition to each board member. In Memoriam of Outstanding Shag Supporters

This past two months in our shag world have been difficult for me personally. A number of people that I have known, some well known throughout our shag world and some not, have passed. I want to let you know about these people because all of them had a connection to me in this wonderful shag lifestyle that we enjoy.

Dancing brings us all together in so many ways that we do not realize. So, I want to share some small tidbits with you. Those we lost are John Hutchins, "Fat Harold" Bessent, Eddie Monsour, Dave Bushey, and Dr. Phil Sawyer.

John Hutchins was a former Exalted Ruler of the Elks Lodge here in Morganton. He was the leader when I became an Elk member. He and his wife Dawn took shag lessons from me and Robin years back and I enjoyed teaching them both how to shag. We visited John's house and it was the first and only time I taught someone to shag in their own home.

John taught me the meaning of being an Elk Member and the importance of a good relationship between the Morganton Elks Lodge and our shag club. John lost his battle with cancer only recently.

Fat Harold was known throughout the shag world for having been the owner of one of the most recognizable shag landmarks anywhere. Of course I am talking about Fat Harold's Beach Club which many SBSC members have visited. Fat Harold did much to promote our dance, our music, and our lifestyle. He was truly an iconic figure in our dance and his name will always remain as a beacon of light that shines on our love of this wonderful dance and the places we go to enjoy it. I encourage you to learn more about his life and the many things he did to give to others so that our world, especially our dance world, would be a better place.

Eddie Monsour was a great leader in our shag community. He was the director of the Hall of Fame Foundation that is one of the great

philanthropic ventures seeking to assist shaggers and others who need assistance. He was a great dancer and was inducted as was Fat Harold into the Beach Shaggers Hall of Fame. Eddie had a voice that was very commanding and he spoke on numerous occasions at Association of



Carolina Shag Clubs' meetings. Eddie was awarded the Shag Icon award in 2005 and was a member of the Fayetteville Area Shag Club.

Dave Bushey was the past president of the Northern Virginia Shag Club and was deep into preparations for the ACSC Summer Workshop that will be held starting July 10th of this month near Washington, DC. He found out he had cancer and it progressed rapidly and he left us June 25th. He attended our Megafest party with his wife Angie last year while he was still president of his club. Robin and I had gotten to know Dave very well during these last several years as our lifestyle brings us all together at SOS and we held the same passion for our dance.

Lastly, we lost one of the true fathers of our shag world. He was one of the true mentors of many who like I, want to see our dance, our music, and our lifestyle prosper and flourish. If it was not for Dr. Phil Sawyer, the SOS we have come to love would not exist. The Association of Carolina Shag Clubs might have never existed. He helped to start ACSC and was responsible for the purchase of SOS.

He lived in Columbia, SC and was an avid South Carolina Gamecock fan as I am. He would tell me stories about so many different things when I would get together with him and talk. He remembered everything so well including dates and names and listening to him talk about our shag history was spellbinding. I

had the opportunity in May to visit him while he was in the hospital with his wonderful wife Miss Chick. I also had lunch with him in his favorite eatery in Columbia, The Mousetrap, not too many months before my last visit with him.

He was the first Shag Icon inducted in 1995. Many of you own his book, Save The Last Dance For Me. If you don't own it, I suggest you consider owning it. It is truly a piece of shag history. He was a member of the first shag club in ACSC, the Columbia Shag Club.

Our dance and everything involved with it is a fragile existence. Each one of our Sandy Beach Shag Club members represents an

important part of the framework that makes up our local club, our regional presence, and our national representation.

The future of our great Carolina Shag lies in the hands of those that love it now, and to those who we pass it on down to. Each one of these amazing people who have passed on to that Shadow Shaggers Heaven have left us big shoes to fill. Each one had a profound role to play in my shag life and it is our destiny to join together and pass our passion on to others as they did.
