

People have asked me why I joined the shag club, and why this club means so much to me; well here goes.

On December 30 th 2009 at 1:31A.M. my wife of 37 years past away and left me with a very large hole in my heart, a hole that I could not imagine ever being filled. In 2010 I tried to get out, my family was great about trying to help me, but I felt alone no matter where I was or the size of group I was with.

In 2011, I heard about this group called Sandy Beach Shag Club (I belonged to the Club back in the 80's) and I thought I should give them another try. I mean I knew how to shag, and I love beach music. I came and I stood by myself for a while and asked myself why I was putting myself through this. I felt so alone I hurt all over; but I stayed to see what might happen! Some of the ladies would come up and ask me to dance and so I did. The first time was very hard but it got easier as the night went on and themore dances I came to. Before I knew it I had a whole new set of friends and started to go other places.

Then I got the courage to ask a young lady out on a date and boy did I feel out of place! I asked then asked another, and another, and after a while, I was about to just give up because I just wasn't feeling it!

Nothing was right.

One Sunday at a deck party in September

of 2012, I was sitting with some of my new found friends, when a beautiful girl walked in front of me and believe it or not sat down beside me, and I was 13 years old again! I didn't know what to say or what to do but knew I better think of something quickly or she might leave. We talked and found that we had some things in common; we had both lost our spouses to cancer. To have someone to talk to that knows how you feel and what it means when you say certain things is unexplainable.

I told her later that when she walked in front of me that everything went black and white

except for her, she was in the most beautiful color I had seen in a long time! I have been laughed at for giving that description, but it is the truth! I walked her to her car that night and danced with her the next Thursday night at the Elks for shag lessons and have been dancing with her ever since. As you may have guessed,

Wilma is now my wife and I must tell you that in her case wife rhymes with life because she has helped me get mine back!

Sandy Beach Shag Club is in fact a social club, but for me it is a whole lot more. Thanks Sandy Beach






