#### **Great Information on Shag Etiquette...**

I think it is a good thing to reprint information that is always relevant to our shag club especially with new members entering our group all the time. Here is a great article on Shag Etiquette.

#### **Shag Etiquette**

- Asking a partner: It is equally permissible for a woman to ask a man as it is for a man to ask a woman. Take your partner's hand onto the dance floor and at the end of the dance, thank your partner.
- 2. If you don't want to dance, say "No thank you." Don't dance with someone if you just turned down a request to dance. Please, if someone says "no thanks" do not be persistent, take them at their word.
- 3. It is not polite to correct your partner on the dance floor. Remember this is a social club (have fun).
- 4. It is not polite to offer instruction to someone in a social dance setting (or in a dance class if you are not the instructor). Let's face it; you may be the one doing the step wrong. Unless they ask for help or are hurting you, don't teach. If your partner requests help, kindly take them off to the side away from the other social dancers.
- 5. DANCERS BUMP INTO THE NICEST PEOPLE and it isn't even a contact sport. Be aware of the dancers around you! if you bump into someone, kick someone or step on someone's foot, or if they bump into you, apologize whether it was your fault or theirs. Show concern that no serious injury has occurred. It's a fairly accepted practice that when a collision occurs, apologize, EVEN if it wasn't your fault.
- 6. DANCERS, USE SELECTIVE FLOOR PLACEMENT - Find your Spot and keep your Slot! The first person on the floor usually has the right to set the slot of the

- dance. Dance Small! Nobody likes to be pushed around the floor.
- 7. Please step off the dance floor if you're not dancing. If you are drinking a beverage of any kind or smoking, keep off the dance floor because of damage to the floor.



- 8. Leaders: if dancing with a less experienced partner, keep the steps simple at first and build to the level that your partner can handle. Leading should be defined as "the art of making your partner comfortable." Work as a team, don't showboat.
- 9. Leaders, protect your partner, since you are directing her movement, you need to be sure to protect her safety.
- 10. Leaders, if you must count and give verbal leads, keep it low enough that just you and your partner can hear. It can confuse those around you and besides, just because you can count doesn't mean "you are on the beat."

The SBSC is planning a trip to the Brushy Mountain Shag Club dance/party, in Wilkesboro, NC on Sat Mar 19th. Details as follows:

Only active paid up members of SBSC will be able to ride the bus/van (membership benefit). SBSC will pay the cost of transportation to and from Wilkesboro.

Cost will be \$9.00 per person for non members of BMSC. Cost for members of BMSC will be \$6.00 per person. The extra dollar from each person will go to the bus/van driver as a tip.

You must reserve your seat on the bus/van-TO DO THIS please make a check payable to Sandy Beach Shag Club and mail it to Sanford T. Clark, 4931 S T Clark Road, Morganton, NC 28655. Or you can give your check to any of the above committee members. There will be no refunds once your seat is reserved. You can transfer your seat to another SBSC member if you find that you will not be going after reserving your seat for the trip. You must fill out and sign an Associate Member of BMSC form, (if not a member of that club) which will be given to you on the bus/van. This prefilled out form and seat reservations will allow you to enter the dance without standing in line.

Bring anything you want to eat and drink while traveling to and from Wilkesboro. No drinks of any kind can be taken into the dance/party. There will be a cash bar for your use if needed.

The event will be held at the Holiday Inn Express Hotel, 1700 Winkler Ave, Wilkesboro, NC. Dancing from 8 PM to 11 PM, smoke free, all ABC permits. Mike Harding is the DJ spinning the tunes.

We will leave the Elks Club in Morganton at 6:30 PM, Sat Mar 19th and make one stop in Lenoir, NC. This stop will be at the Belk's Dept store parking lot for those wanting to depart from that area.
