Life On A Cruise Ship and the Carolina Shag

Robin and I went on the cruise ship, Carnival Miracle, for our 15 day SOS Shag Cruise to Hawaii. We spent almost ten days at sea getting to and from Hawaii with 62 other SOS Cruise members. We visited Kahului, Honolulu, Nawiliwili, Kona, Hilo, and Ensenada, Mexico. The time at sea gave us plenty of time to dance with our DJ, Mike Harding! We also gave an exhibition in the main Atrium to all passengers and crew that wanted to attend. We had so much fun and made many new friends on the ship. 
